VINTAGE 1991

Seventeen inches of rain in March ended the prospect of a drought year. The growing season was cool and protracted, producing a large crop and a late harvest. The vintage yielded wines of great structure, balance and length, offering persistent layers of flavor and a sweet middle palate.
